

Meraki Mobile Device Management Guidelines for Family Owned iPads

Meraki is a mobile device management software that allows Pike to manage a large number of iPads. Meraki allows Pike to apply and change network settings on hundreds of remote iPads from a central control panel eliminating the need to make the changes one at a time on each iPad. While Meraki has many features and capabilities, Pike will only use a small subset of these capabilities.

Below is a list of the Meraki features that Pike will use:

- Install network security settings such as WIFI passwords for Pike's networks
- Enforce security settings like passcode minimum requirements
- Install Pike Purchased Apps and Books
- Install commonly used web shortcuts

Pike will not use Meraki for the following purposes:

- To locate or track an iPad location. Families should install the Find My iPhone app for this purpose.
- To report or record information about the configuration of the iPad or for remote control or access of the iPad outside of:
 - Network Security settings
 - Installing Pike Purchased Apps and Books
 - Installing commonly used web shortcuts

Meraki does not have the following capabilities:

- Access to contacts, email, bookmarks or other personal information on the iPad
- Ability to remotely view an iPad screen
